Carolina Marathon Association, a non-profit organizations that has been conducting major running events in Columbia since 1977. The organization has sponsored and produced numerous national running events including the 1996 and 2000 U.S. Olympic Trials Women's Marathon. The Carolina Marathon Association also conducts the annual Heart & Sole Women's 5-Miler.

<u>Background on Future Scholar:</u> Launched in 2002, Future Scholar has achieved tremendous growth in just 15 years, helping families in the state and across the nation save for college. Highlights of Future Scholar's 15-year growth include:
